



CPSC ADULT INDOOR SOCCER LEAGUE RULES and REGULATIONS

Officiating

- ⚽ The League Referee Assignor appoints all of our referees. We stand by and respect all the decisions made by our referees.
- ⚽ We do, however, monitor our referees and attempt to provide top quality officiating. Comments or concerns will be heard from participants if a referee is not performing in a professional manner. In the unforeseen circumstance that appointed referees are not available, the League Convenor reserves the right to appoint, at its discretion, a replacement referee.

Referee Assault

- ⚽ Referee assault will be dealt with by the CPSC Disciplinary Committee.

Appeals

Eligibility of a player

- ⚽ Teams may protest based on the eligibility of a player. This protest can be based on a player playing while under suspension or not being registered. This must be done before the match (if player does not play then no protest is required).
- ⚽ For late player arrivals, if the eligibility of the player is questioned and they participate in the match, the team appealing is required to submit the appeal by email to AISL Convenors within 48 hours of the match in question.
- ⚽ The referee **must** be informed that a protest is being lodged, and the reason for it
- ⚽ The AISL Convenors will review the issue and will come to a decision within 48 hours of the appeal being lodged.
- ⚽ If the appealing team is successful in their appeal, the match result will be altered (if necessary). If the appealing team loses then the match outcome will stand.

Discipline issues

- ⚽ Teams may appeal any dismissal issued to a player (including 2 cautions in one match).
- ⚽ Teams may not appeal single cautions in a match, nor the accumulation of cautions.
- ⚽ Should a team wish to appeal a disciplinary issue, the following must occur:
 1. Submit the appeal by email to AISL Convenors within 48 hours of the match in question.
 2. Provide a \$100.00 bond or cheque within 48 hours of the match in question, payable to the Carleton Place Soccer Club. This must be dropped off at the Beckwith Municipal Office.
- ⚽ The CPSC Disciplinary Committee will hold a hearing, which will consist of three arbiters appointed by the CPSC Disciplinary Committee Chairperson.
- ⚽ If the appealing player is successful in their appeal, they will not be found not guilty, will not be suspended or be fined, and their \$100.00 bond will be returned. If the appealing player loses the appeal, they will be found guilty, and face a suspension and fine, and the \$100.00 bond will be retained by the CPSC.
- ⚽ Note: The hearing decision is final.
